

DRESS CODE

All students are expected to be in full uniform at all times, except for specified "uniform-free" days of which you will receive advance notice. All students are expected to arrive at school clean, neatly groomed, and dressed appropriately. Students will begin wearing uniforms on the first day of school, and the uniform will be worn daily until school is dismissed in June.

Uniforms are purchased from Collegiate House and consist of:

Girls K-5

1. Blue plaid jumper (choice of 2 styles)* with Cheverus emblem
 2. Light blue blouse
 3. Blue plaid tie
 4. Navy blue knee socks or tights
 5. Dress shoes* - dark soft-soled shoes
- Optional—Navy blue cardigan sweater.

Girls 6-8

1. Blue plaid skirt*
 2. White long or short sleeve blouse
 3. Navy blue vest
 4. Navy blue knee socks or tights
 5. Dress shoes* - dark soft-soled shoes
- Optional—Navy blue cardigan or V-neck pullover sweater. A white turtleneck may be worn from December until March

* SHOES—Platform shoes or heels may not be more than one inch. No open toe or open back shoes.

* SKIRTS & JUMPERS— No more than 2" from the knee

Sweaters - If students choose to wear sweaters in the classroom, the blue uniform sweater is allowed.

Jackets - No jackets may be worn in the classroom.

Sweatshirts - No sweatshirts may be worn in the classroom. (See gym uniform reference for exception.)

Gym Uniform - The gym uniform is worn on gym day only. The gym uniform T-shirt may be worn in place of the sweat shirt.

Gym Uniform (from Collegiate House)

1. Blue gym sweat suit
2. Blue gym shorts
3. Blue gym T-shirt
4. Sneakers (no platform sneakers)

Headbands

Uniform or solid navy headbands may be worn.

Earrings

Earrings may be worn by girls only (one earring per ear in ear lobe). Girls are not to wear dangling earrings or large loop earrings.

Make-Up

Only light almost unseeable make-up is allowed. Only clear fingernail polish is allowed. Nails must be short and neatly trimmed. Artificial nails are not allowed.

Hair Style Regulations

Haircuts will be conservative. Layered (without lines) mushroom style haircuts are permitted. No fad haircuts for boys or girls are permitted. No unusual or two-toned bleached hair colors are permitted. There will be no hair tails allowed. Girls' hair should clear the eye area of the face. Boys' hair should not be longer than the top of the shirt collar.

It is expected that parents see that their children follow this dress code. Students who choose to ignore the dress code regulations will be expected to rectify the dress code violations. If violations are not rectified, students will be held out of class. **All matters of interpretation are the responsibility of the Vice-Principal and the Principal whose judgments will be final.**

Boys K-5

1. Navy blue pants
 2. Navy belt
 3. Shirts, see below
 4. Navy blue tie
 5. Dress shoes* - dark soft-soled shoes
- Optional—Navy blue V-neck pullover or cardigan sweater.

* SHIRTS

- Boys - K — light blue long or short sleeve polo shirt with school name embroidered by uniform company.
- Boys - 1-5 — light blue long or short sleeve dress shirt.

Boys 6-8

Same as above with one exception: 1. White long or short sleeve shirt

* SHOES—Work boots (no steel toes) are allowed during the winter season. All shoes with laces must be tied.
